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NOTE ON REGULATIONS AND NORMS APPLICABLE FOR VTU-ETR 2021

(A) UGC Regulations for admission to Research Programmes

Visvesvaraya Technological University has adopted the following clauses of UGC Regulations for admission to VTU Research Programmes conducted at the VTU approved Research Centres.

Reference: 1. University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./ Ph.D. Degrees) Regulations, 2016, dated 5th May, 2016.

- **Clause 1.2** They (These Regulations) shall apply to every University established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial Act, or a State Act, every affiliated college, and every Institution Deemed to be a University under Section 3 of UGC Act, 1956.
- **Clause 5.4** Higher Education Institutes (HEIs) as mentioned in Clause 1.2 shall admit candidates by a two stage process through:
- **Clause 5.4.1** An Entrance Test shall be qualifying with qualifying marks as 50%. The syllabus of the Entrance Test shall consist of 50% of research methodology and 50% shall be subject specific. The

Entrance Test shall be conducted at the Centre(s) notified in advance (changes of Centres, if any, also to be notified well in advance) at the level of the individual HEI as mentioned in clause 1.2; and

- **Clause 5.4.2** An interview/viva-voce to be organized by the HEI as mentioned in clause 1.2 when the candidates are required to discuss their research interest/area through a presentation before a duly constituted Department Research Committee.

Reference: 2. University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degrees) (1st amendment) Regulations, 2018, dated 27th August, 2018.

- **Clause 2.** The following proviso shall be added to the clause 5.4.1 of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degrees) Regulations, 2016 “provided that a relaxation of 5 % of marks (from 50% to 45%) shall be allowed for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy layers)/Differently-abled category in the entrance examination conducted by the Universities.

Reference: 3. University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degrees) (2nd amendment) Regulations, 2018, dated 16th October, 2018.

- **Clause 2.** The following proviso shall be added to the clause 5.4.2 of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degrees) Regulations, 2016.

“Provided that for selection of candidates, a weightage of 70 % to the entrance test and 30 % to the performance of in the interview/viva-voce shall be given”.

(B) VTU – ETR result announcement and Admission procedure adopted by VTU to Research Programmes

(1) The Candidates who have secured 50 marks and above under general category and, 45 marks and above under reservation category in VTU –ETR conducted for 100 marks, are eligible to appear for the Pre-Registration Interview.

(2) The eligibility of Candidates for admission to Research programmes shall be notified after adding the marks secured in the Pre-Registration Interview with VTU-ETR marks as detailed in reference:3 above.

(3) The allotment of the Research Supervisor/s shall be based on the merit decided by the sum of VTU-ETR marks and Pre-Registration Interview marks, and availability of the vacancy position with the Research Supervisors.
