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From the President's desk

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



OBITUARY



Prof. M. R. Gajendragad (1931 – 2014)

Former Vice-Chancellor of Kuvempu University Prof. Muhyuddin Rahamatulla Gajendragad (M.R.Gajendragad) passed away on 2-6-2014 at his daughter's residence in Hubli at the age of 83 years, after a brief hospitalization and prolonged illness.

Prof.M.R.G started his career as lecturer in Anjuman College Dharwad. He worked as Principal of S.A.M Composite Pre-University College, Gadag for a brief period. He served as Professor of Chemistry at the prestigious Regional Engineering College Suratkal (presently NITK) between 1960 to 1982. As Professor and Chairman from 1982 till 1991 he laid the foundation to the Department of Chemistry of the

newly established Mangalore University. Later he was appointed as the Vice-Chancellor of Kuvempu University in January 1991 and held that office with great efficiency and did his best to the development of the University up to January 1996. After retirement he served as member of Karnataka Science Academy and in various other academic committees/bodies.

Prof.M.R.Gajendragad with his wide reading had great command over the languages, Sanskrit, Kannada, English and Hindi. He had been forthright in his views as a good speaker. He had spoken forcefully on a variety of social issues and problems.

Prof.M.R.Gajendragad was predeceased by his wife and survived by one son and four daughters. He was born in Itagi village of Rona taluk of Gadag district. He had his early education in Gajendragad, studied Pre-University and B.Sc in Karnataka College Dharwad and did M.Sc in Chemistry at Karnataka University. Later he obtained Ph.D in Co-ordination Chemistry from IIT, Kanpur.

He was an active member of FVCK. The FVCK mourns deeply his death, as a mark of respect one minute silence was observed at the Executive Committee meeting of the FVCK and passed resolution to the departed soul rest in peace.

Proposed New Programmes

- 1) During the month of December, 2014 a Seminar on “**Emergence of princely Mysore as a Modern State 1902-1947**” has been proposed with the financial assistance of Indian Council of Historical Research, New Delhi.
- 2) A Seminar on “**Mode of Appointment of Vice Chancellors**” is proposed to be held during the last week of December 2014.
- 3) A National Seminar on “**Structure and Governance of Universities in India**”- is proposed in Jan,2015.

RASHTRIYA UCCHATAR SHIKSHANA ABHIYAN (RUSA)

- 1) The success of SSA and RMSA, has laid a strong foundation for primary and secondary Education in India. Likewise RUSA proposes a new centrally sponsored scheme for Higher Education with a strategic intervention for improvement of access, equity and quality in Higher Education and focuses on State Universities and Colleges through a centrally sponsored scheme in a MISSION mode.
- 2) In order to be eligible for funding under RUSA, states will have to fulfill certain pre requisites, which include the creation of a State Higher Education Council preparation of State perspective plans, commitment of stipulated share of funds towards RUSA, Academic, Sectoral and Institutional Governance reforms, filling faculty positions etc. Under the scheme an initial amount will be provided to State Governments to prepare them for complying with these prior requirement.
- 3) At the national level, the scheme will be implemented by RUSA Mission Authority and assisted by Project Approval Board (PAB, the technical support group) and the Project Directorate. The main agency, through which RUSA will work in the states, will be the State Higher Education Council an autonomous body, which has a statutory power. It is expected to

perform planning, monitoring and evaluation, quality assurance and Academic functions as well as advisory and funding functions. It will be assisted by the State project Directorate and the State Technical support group. In every Institution, the governing body and a project monitoring unit will oversee the project progress.

- 4) The key objectives of RUSA are to improve Access, Equality and quality in Higher Education through planned development which includes creating new Academic Institutions, expanding and upgrading of the existing ones, to develop institutions that are self reliant in terms of quality education, professionally managed and characterized by research and provide students with education that is relevant to them as well as the nation as a whole.

Recommendations sent to the State and Central Governments.

The following recommendations of the seminars were sent to the State Government, both to the Ministry of Higher Education, Ministry of Agriculture (Agriculture and Allied) and Ministry of Health (Medical and Allied) for the needful action.

A) The National Seminar on “Applications of Science and Technology to Promote Agricultural Growth and Value Addition” held on 2nd & 3rd December, 2012 at JSS College of Arts, Commerce and Science, Mysore-570025 with the blessings of His Holiness Jagadguru Sri Shivarathri Desshikendra Mahaswamiji, president, JSS Mahavidyapeetha, Mysore, & Dr.S.Ayyappan, Director General (ICAR) and Secretary (DARE), GOI, Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi was the chief guest & Dr.Swapan Kumar Dutta, Deputy Director General (Crop Science) ICAR, GOI Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi was guest of honour.

Recommendations :

The future strategies for agriculture should be aimed at achieving higher yields with lesser inputs such as water, chemical fertilizers and pesticides, labour, etc.

- To prioritize some crops of national importance and carry out highly focused research.
- On issues pertaining to science and technology, the policy makers should consult the scientists and scientific bodies and be guided by their recommendations for policy decisions. Otherwise, such reputed scientific institutions and academies remain under-utilized.
- Our country which was one of the first to establish an independent Dept of Biotechnology way back in 1986 needs to adopt policies that would enable bringing out more Bio-tech products without undue delay, and without compromising on the quality of research and safety.
- Vigorous upliftment of regulatory system need to be contemplated.
- Commercial crop of BT cotton need to be encouraged as there are no scientifically modern adverse effects on human, animals, soil and environment.

- The country, both in public and private sectors, has spent considerable resources in developing new technologies. If deployment of such technologies is delayed, it would amount to a colossal waste of national resources.

In the interest of promoting science and technology which shall remain a dynamic growth factor, we urge the government authorities to take a constructive stand on policy issues based on scientific evidences.

B) A Seminar on “Assessment & Accreditation of Education Institutions and vision of NAAC for 21st Century” was held on 6th September 2013 at Forum premises. Sri. Rajneesh Goel, Principal Secretary Higher, Education, GOK, Dr.K.S.Sriprakash, Vice-Chancellor, R.G.U.H.S, Dr.N.PrabhuDev, Former Vice Chancellor, Dr.A.N.Rai, Director NAAC took part in the discussions.

Recommendations :

- To consider appointing Academicians, Academic Administrators, Eminent Educationists, Eminent Scientists and Former Vice-Chancellors as members of University Syndicates to utilize their vast knowledge and experience in their field of specializations.
- To accord autonomous status to more number of Higher Education Institutions to match in accordance of UGC regulations and to evolve a method to monitor their performance.
- To take appropriate measures to uphold the Autonomy of State Universities in the best interest of improving the quality of Higher Education by the authorities.
- In order to maintain the uniform standards, it is recommended to the Ministry of Higher Education / State Universities to establish State level assessment and accreditation councils/bodies on line with NAAC under UGC guidelines to speed-up the process and cover large number of institutions for accreditation.
- The Director, NAAC need to facilitate more number of workshops/seminars for Higher Education institutions to bring awareness and the importance of NAAC accreditation. Further the

Director, NAAC also to give more importance for the role of IQAC and AQAR with more efficient and effective two way feed-back mechanism.

C) Recommendation on the “The Regulatory Conundrum of GM Crops: How to untangle the Political mess?” was held on 29.11.2013 ,Prof.S.Shantharam, Seed Science Centre, IOWA State University, USA was the key speaker.

The following Recommendations were sent to the State and Central Governments for necessary action

- The Govt has to take bold realistic steps to ensure the Biotechnology Regulatory Authority of India’ (BRAI) in place as early as possible.
 - The policy makers should consult the scientists/ expert committees/ scientific academies and to be guided by their recommendations for policy decisions on issues pertaining to Science and Technology.
 - There is a need to educate the farmers and the general public about this technology to build the confidence.
 - To benefit the farming community the policy for approving GM-Technology products should be implemented at the earliest.
- D) A Seminar on “Need for Electoral Reforms in India” held on 14 December, 2013 at Forum premises Bangalore. Nadoja Dr.Justice V.S.Malimath,Chairman,Karnataka State Law

Commission, Govt. of Karnataka, & Dr. Vijayakumar.V, Professor of Law, NLSIU, Bangalore and Former VC, The Tamil Nadu, Dr.Ambedkar Law University Chennai took part in the discussions.

Recommendations:

- a) More and more intellectuals should come forward to participate in elections as voters and to ensure good candidates getting elected to Parliament and State Assembly.
 - b) Constant research should be conducted to find out the methods of strengthening electoral process and FVCK must take the lead in this matter.
 - c) Good governance will follow only when elections are conducted honestly in a transparent manner.
 - d) To disconnect the executives from the legislature, the ministers should not be from the elected category.
- E) A Lecture series on “Sensitization Cum Interaction Programme on Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers Rights Act 2001 “was held on 8th May, 2014 at Forum premises Bangalore Dr.R.R.Hanchinal, Chairperson, PPV & FR Authority, Govt.of.India, New Delhi & Sri.G.Sathish, IFS, Commissioner, Dept of Sericulture, Govt. of Karnataka took part in the discussions.
