### **Policy for promotion of research**


In Higher Education Institutions, research and extension activities are an important part of teaching. Government College (Autonomous), Kalaburagi, has a dynamic educational approach that encourages continuous improvement in teaching, learning, assessment, and research methodologies. This type of upkeep is only achievable with a strong research aptitude. Research enables the creation of knowledge, creativity, and fresh insights for extension efforts, as well as more structured and energetic education. The Government College (Autonomous), Kalaburagi, has a substantial research presence and encourages all faculty and students to participate in outcome-based research.

The following are the key goals of the research policy of Government College (Autonomous), Kalaburagi:

- Multidisciplinary research and education in the basic sciences, applied sciences, social sciences, arts, languages and commerce encouraged.
- To improve the research capacity of Government College (Autonomous), Kalaburagi, by involving faculty members in research that combines the education of a broad group of students, particularly first-generation students and those from low-income families.
- Encourage and promote research that is socially relevant and needs-based, as well as research that is based on values.
- To provide a stimulating intellectual atmosphere in which academics and students from many departments can collaborate on research.
- Industries, minority institutions, and institutions of higher learning are all working together to build research and educational connections with wider populations.
- To form partnerships, collaborations, and outreach programs/initiatives that further the vision Government College (Autonomous), Kalaburagi.

### **Policy for Promotion of Research**

To facilitate research and development activities such as conferences, collaborations, and establishing networks with other institutes in India. This office deals with all research projects funded by various funding agencies in order to facilitate research and development activities such as conferences, collaborations, and establishing networks with other institutes in India and abroad. The office was formed by the college to ensure that administrative matters relating to efficient handling of research endeavours.



Apart from local higher education offices and enterprises, Government College (Autonomous), Kalaburagi encourages its professors to apply for research projects from various funding bodies. A high grade of research output is one of the major factors for the recruitment and promotion under CAS, according to UGC standards.

Government College (Autonomous), Kalaburagi supports faculty members to undertake post-doctoral research, joint research initiatives, and fellowships by offering study leave as required by UGC and universities to spend productive time in research activities on campus or at other universities and institutions throughout the world.

In compliance with the PhD norms of Gulbarga University, Kalaburagi, the qualified faculties are eligible to advise PhD research researchers. All eligible associate professors with the appropriate years of experience are urged to earn a PhD and to publish the required articles in order to be recognised as PhD supervisors.

The college encourages research output in the form of innovation, creativity, and patent filing by providing appropriate recognition and rewards. With Memorandums of Understanding, the college encourages faculty to form networks with other universities in India and internationally (MoUs). The research office compiles reports on various research efforts in the college over the academic year and shares them with IQAC and on the website on a regular basis.

### **Ethics in Research**


Government College (Autonomous), Kalaburagi, places a high priority on encouraging its teachers to follow the ethical criteria of college and the UGC when doing research. In accordance with this, the college has **formed an internal ethics committee for research** involving human and animal subjects, and study proposals must first be approved by the committee before being carried out.

Plagiarism check is another key requirement imposed by the college on all Ph.D. candidates. The theses must be checked for plagiarism, and the certificate must include the signatures of both the research scholar and the research guide. The college provides plagiarism tools to examine research articles, proposals, and project reports.



The college encourages departments to hold workshops on research technique, with an emphasis on research ethics. Faculty members are also made aware of intellectual property rights (IPR), patents, and research ethics through invited speeches.
